

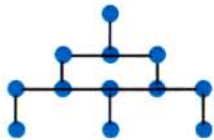


About Us

The **Foreign Language Council of San Diego (FLCSD)** is a volunteer organization of language teachers in San Diego County. Both public and private schools, from elementary through university levels, are represented.

The mission of **FLCSD** is to promote and support the study and teaching of foreign languages. To facilitate that mission, **FLCSD** provides a variety of services and professional development activities for its members and works closely with related organizations.

FLCSD is an affiliate of the **California Language Teachers Association (CLTA)** which oversees and promotes the interests of foreign language study and teaching state-wide. **CLTA** and **FLCSD** have a close working relationship with the **California Foreign Language Project (CFLP)** at Stanford University and the **San Diego International Languages Network (SAILN)**, the **Language Acquisition Resource Center (LARC)** at San Diego State University and other regional affiliates of **CLTA**—all striving to serve and support foreign language study and teaching.

Professional Development

FLCSD sponsors a number of professional development opportunities during the academic year. **Professional Updates** target the research, legislation, program developments, and other topics of interest to members of our profession.

An annual **Shar-A-Thon** provides the opportunity for members to learn from their peers by exchanging materials, lesson ideas, and valuable advice on creating and maintaining successful language programs.

The **Annual Fall Breakfast/Conference** on the first Saturday in December brings professional speakers and the chance to reinforce our strong foreign language teacher network.

In the spring, **CLTA** holds its annual conference and many **FLCSD** members serve as presenters at various sessions. Year-round, more professional development opportunities are offered by **LARC**. The highlight of the summer is the **CLTA/CFLP Summer Seminar** at Santa Barbara.
